



CALL FOR ENTRIES

PURPOSE

A design competition honoring excellence in library interior design. Award winners will demonstrate excellence in aesthetics, design, creativity, function, and satisfaction of the client's objectives.

WHAT TO ENTER

Any library interior design project completed between **October 1, 2009** and **October 1, 2011**. Previous publication is acceptable. The project must be submitted by a legally practicing design professional.

HOW TO ENTER

Compile the following items and mail your submission to IIDA. Enter by **March 30, 2012**.

- a. The completed Entry Form (below) along with your entry fee payment. Please be sure you have indicated the appropriate category on the entry form. A separate entry form must be filled out for each project submitted.
- b. A CD-ROM containing the following:
 - 1. A brief, one-page description of your project. Include specific solutions to the design challenge (i.e. originality, suitability of the design to the project challenges, successful incorporation of interior finishes and furnishings, and benefits to the client). Do not reference your firm's name or use your firm letter-head for this project summary.

- 2. PowerPoint file with up to 3 images of the floor plan(s) followed by 5 to 7 jpeg images of your completed project.

FEE

\$200 per entry for IIDA Members.
 \$250 per entry for Non-Members.
 Entry fees are non-refundable.

Each project may be entered in only one category.
