The Lloy Hack Memorial Fund was established to honor the memory of Lloy Hack, an IIDA Member and highly regarded, award-winning interior designer from Boston. The purpose of this essay competition is to reward a student who is pursuing a degree and ultimately a career in interior design.

STUDENT ESSAY

As a participant in IIDA Mentoring Week, you are encouraged to write an original essay about your mentoring experience. The essay should address how the designer/firm demonstrated outstanding effort and leadership in educating and inspiring you about the profession. Include specific information on activities you took part in, exposure to the field, and your plans for ongoing mentoring. Your essay should be between 500-750 words in length, double spaced, and in a standard font. Please include your name, address, email, and telephone number on the front cover of your essay.

AWARD

The student who authors the winning essay will receive \$1,500.

ENTRY DETAILS

There is no cost to participate in the 2010 Lloy Hack Essay Competition. Entrants must have participated in IIDA's Student Mentoring Week 2010, February 1-5, 2010.
